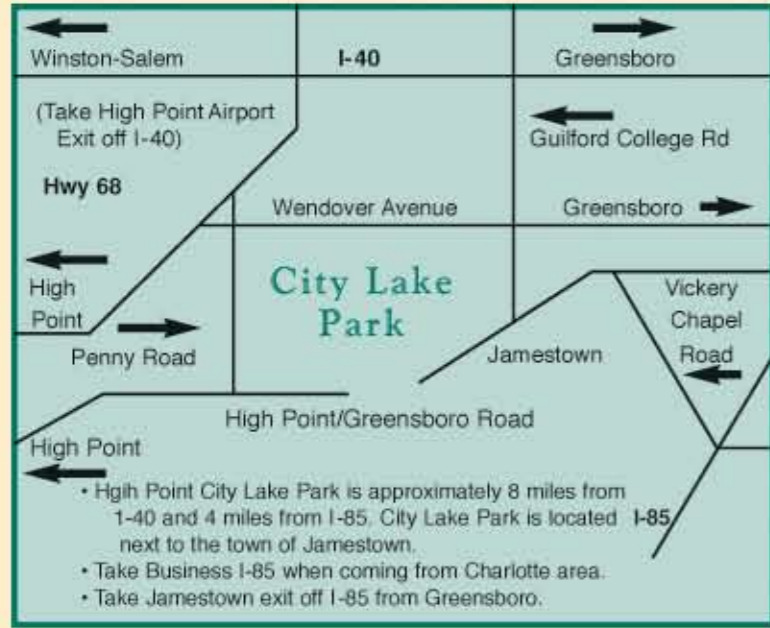


DIRECTIONS TO HIGH POINT CITY LAKE PARK

GROUP RATES:

RIDES - An all day discount pass for unlimited train and merry go round rides is available for groups of 25 or more. Unlimited miniature golf can be added to each pass for an additional fee. Final pass price depends on the size of the group. Group rate given only if passes bought at one time.

TOUR BOAT - Charter the tour boat by the hour for groups. Advance reservations must be made.

POOL - A fee discount is given for use of the pool for groups of 20 or more. Group rate given only if passes bought at one time.

HISTORICAL INFORMATION - The park is located on part of the original site of Old Jamestown. There are two restored historical buildings dating from the 1800's located in the park. One is a Quaker Friends Meeting House with cemetery and the other is the Richard Mendenhall Store. The park has also been the site of a mid 1700's gristmill, a gold mine, and a Confederate uniform factory. The Woccon Indians were thought to have been the earliest inhabitants of the area.

EXCLUSIVE RENTALS OF PARK FACILITIES -

Companies or groups may rent all of the park or the Camp Ann area exclusively for the facilities approved uses. Park rentals are allowed only during certain times of the year, the Camp Ann area is available year round. The amusement rides maybe available for private rental during the off season. The pool and waterslide are available for private rental before or after normal summer operating hours. Contact the Park Manager at (336) 883-3503 for specific information on exclusive rentals.

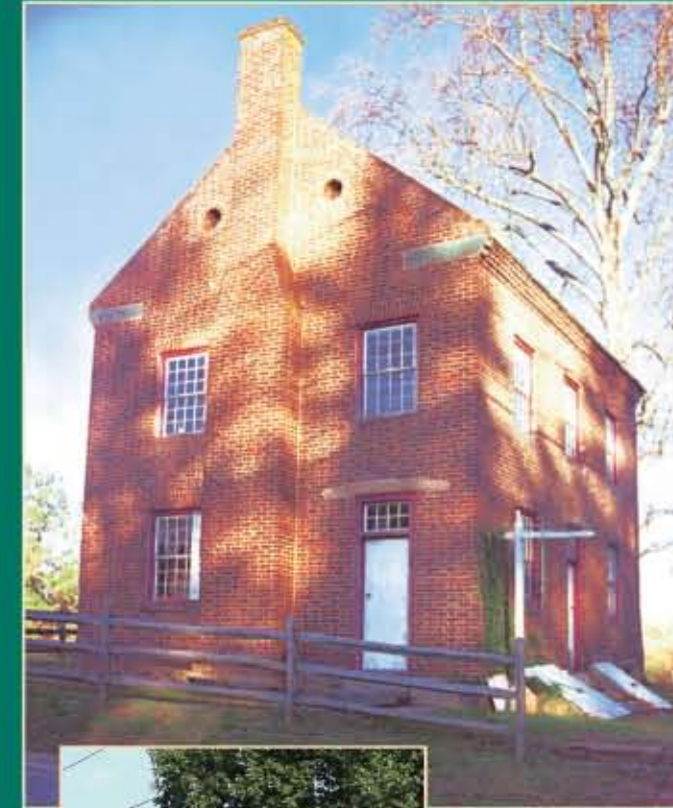

HIGH POINT'S CITY LAKE PARK

is one of the most beautiful, family friendly parks in Piedmont North Carolina. The park with its unique recreational facilities attracts more than 250,000 visitors each year. The park is located next to the Town of Jamestown with easy access from most major highways.

PICNIC SHELTERS - There are ten shelters located throughout the park ranging in capacity from 40 to over 500 people. The shelter fees vary according to shelter size and amount of time rented. Please call (336)883-3498 for information or to make shelter reservations.

PICNIC TABLES - There are freestanding picnic tables and grills located in the main part of the park available on a first-come basis.

AMUSEMENT RIDES - The park, offers for family enjoyment, a miniature train ride, a merry go round ride (adults can ride both), and a 30 passenger excursion boat ride. Tickets are sold at the park concession stand.



MINIATURE GOLF - A 18 hole course offers a challenging fun time for the entire family.

PLAYGROUNDS - The park offers two handicapped accessible playgrounds. The main playground boasts one of the largest and longest play pieces in the state. A new smaller playground is located in the Camp Ann picnic area.

BOATING AND FISHING - High Point City Lake is a 340 acre lake used for drinking water and for recreation. Bank and boat fishing are allowed with proper permits and licenses. The park's marina rents fishing boats year round and seasonally rents its canoes and pedal boats. Private boats (certain restrictions apply) may launch at the marina ramp. Call (336) 883-3498 for specific information on the use of the lake

SWIMMING - The park is home to one of the largest public pools in the Southeast. There is a large shallow wading pool for small children located next to the main pool.

WATERSLIDES - Two new exciting waterslides were completed in 2004. The waterslides are part of the pool complex.

GYMNASIUM - The gymnasium is available for rent year round. The gym is suitable for most types of large group events. Advance reservations must be made for its use.

FIELD STAGE - A 20' x 50' stage, used for special events, is available by special reservation only. The stage is equipped with power hookups adequate for most events.

CONCESSION/TICKET STANDS - The park has two concession/ticket stands. One is located in the main part of the park and the other one at the pool complex. Drinks, snacks, packaged food, etc. are available at both locations.

PARK OPERATION - The park and lake are open year-round, weather permitting, except for the Christmas and New Year holidays. Enjoy the amusement rides from the last weekend in April through the second weekend in October. The pool opens Memorial Day weekend and remains open until the week before Guilford County Schools open.
